Oklahomans Celebrate First 4/20 after Medical Marijuana Legalization

OKC 4/20 Event to Offer Free Entertainment and Education with 20+ Performers

Oklahomans are celebrating 4/20 a whole new way this year for the first time after medical marijuana was legalized. Chronic Palooza at the State Fair Park of Oklahoma City is expected to be the largest free 4/20 event in OKC for the people, by the people.
